Beware the Dog: Mosaic Workshop

David Jack Director, Melbourne Mural Studio P/L



The mosaic theme that often occurs in early Roman works is a mosaic that is public warning at the entrance of a house **Cave Canem** (beware the dog). This will be the image for you to create your own mosaic.

David Jack, Australian mural and mosaic artist, will show you the mosaics of Pompeii and provide a short history of Australia's mosaics.



About the workshop You will create your own mosaic in the style of a Pompeii mosaic. David will give participants an understanding of the steps involved in • Creating a mosaic • Re-creating an image from Pompeii • Material handling and traditional methods introduced (materials and tools included).

Australia's mosaic tradition dates back to the 1920s with Napier Waller being the first to bring the vision and possibilities of murals and mosaics to Australia. Harold Freedman later also took on the Italian grand art vision similarly with huge painted and mosaic projects, mostly in his role as the State Artist for Victoria. David has been working professionally in the arts for the last 30 plus years, mainly in the fields of painted and mosaic murals.

David (and Joe Attard) formed the Melbourne Mural Studio in 1989 to create major mosaic and painted mural projects, many on a huge scale for civic developments across Australia. He commenced mural and mosaic work with Harold Freedman in Melbourne in 1973 whilst concluding a Diploma Art and Design at Monash University (Caulfield). David worked with Harold on major projects for 13 years. Harold had worked with Napier Waller as a young man, so there is a continuous thread of mosaic tradition in Australia.
