James is a traditionally trained masterstonemason.

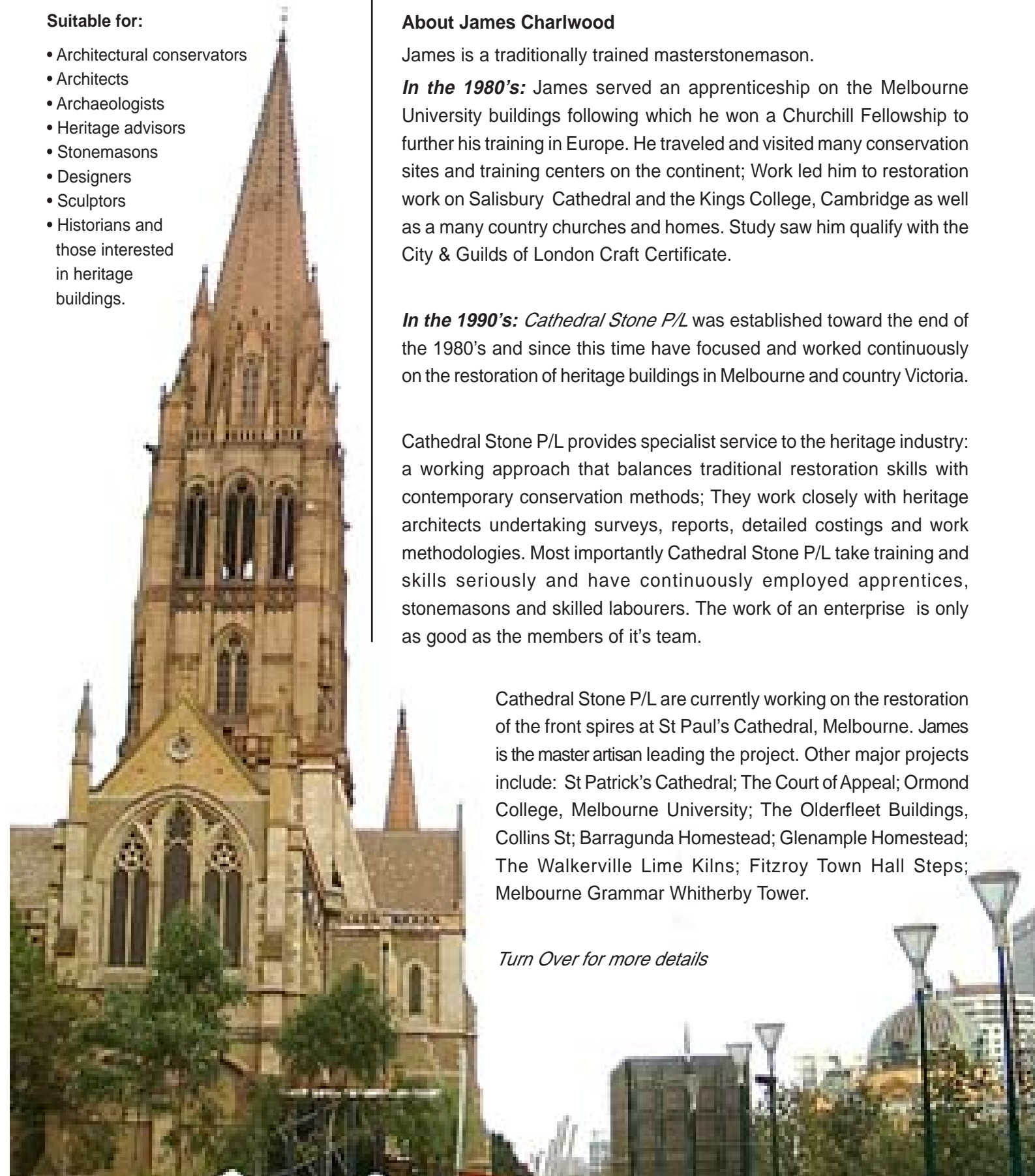
In the 1980's: James served an apprenticeship on the Melbourne University buildings following which he won a Churchill Fellowship to further his training in Europe. He traveled and visited many conservation sites and training centers on the continent; Work led him to restoration work on Salisbury Cathedral and the Kings College, Cambridge as well as a many country churches and homes. Study saw him qualify with the City & Guilds of London Craft Certificate.

In the 1990's: *Cathedral Stone P/L* was established toward the end of the 1980's and since this time have focused and worked continuously on the restoration of heritage buildings in Melbourne and country Victoria.

Cathedral Stone P/L provides specialist service to the heritage industry: a working approach that balances traditional restoration skills with contemporary conservation methods; They work closely with heritage architects undertaking surveys, reports, detailed costings and work methodologies. Most importantly Cathedral Stone P/L take training and skills seriously and have continuously employed apprentices, stonemasons and skilled labourers. Cathedral Stone P/L are currently working on the restoration of the front spires at St Paul's Cathedral, Melbourne. James is the master artisan leading the project.
